



# PSHE at Crow Orchard School

PSHE is the planned developmental programme of learning designed to help learners to develop the knowledge skills and understanding they need to manage their lives now and in the future.

It deals with real life issues that affect children and young people. Their families and their communities and engages with the social and economic realities of their lives, experiences and attitudes.

Our PSHE runs on a series of whole school themes which are differentiated for each year group.

Each theme begins with a 30 minute assembly on Mondays which introduces the theme to the whole school. This is then followed up by additional activities during the week.

The themes are :-

## Autumn Term 1- Rights and responsibilities

### **Objectives**

- *To understand why we need rules in our world*
- *To know what it means to be kind and respectful*
- *To know why we need to listen*
- *To understand good classroom rules*
- *To understand how we should move through the school and why*
- *To know how we can hurt people if we don't use our hands, feet and objects properly*
- *To know why we need to look after things*

## Autumn term 2- Happy to be me

### **Objectives**

- *Children can identify and name some feelings*
- *Children can work effectively with a partner*
- *Children know that sometimes people are sad*
- *Children can talk about what they like and don't like*
- *Children can make simple choices*
- *Children know what makes people happy*

## Spring term 1- Staying safe

### **Objectives**

- *Children understand that sometimes we need to take medicines to make us feel better*

- *To be able to identify items at home which are dangerous substances and where they might be found*
- *To know that some people choose to smoke tobacco and drink alcohol and that there are laws about this*
- *They can describe the nature and consequences of bullying and know that it is wrong*
- *Understand that sometimes people can make you do things you don't want to do*
- *People who help to keep me safe*

## Spring term 2- Growing and changing

### **Objectives**

- *Children will value their own families and understand why they are special*
- *Children can name correct words for external parts of the body*
- *Children can explain ways of keeping clean*
- *Children know what keeps them healthy*
- *They can explain that people grow from young to old*
- *To celebrate the birth of a new family member*

## Summer term 1- Money, Money, Money

### **Objectives**

- *They understand that people work for money*
- *They can demonstrate how to look after and save money*
- *They can talk about a range of jobs that people do to earn money*
- *To understand that money should be kept safe*
- *To understand that spare money can work for us*
- *To understand that spare money can work for us*

## Summer term 2- Prevent

### **Objectives**

- *To know that we are special*
- *To understand how to be a good friend*
- *To know what their local community is*
- *To look at different parts of the world and people who live there*
- *To identify differences and similarities between people*
- *To understand who makes the rules/laws which keep people safe*
